

Regional Water Planning Council Meeting Update

On March 12, 2009, members of each of the state's ten regional water planning councils met for a kick-off meeting at the Georgia Aquarium in Atlanta where they were addressed by Governor Perdue and provided with a shared understanding of basic water resource issues, and the purposes and process for regional water planning council activities. Since that time, each regional council has convened their first and second round of meetings, taking place in May and June respectively. The third round of council meetings has been scheduled to take place in mid-September and the fourth round of council meetings tentatively set for November.
